WHAT IS A CELEBRATION OF LIFE?

Celebrations of life are a type of end-of-life ceremony where people come together to celebrate the unique life of the deceased. Celebrations of life are commonly held after physical remains have been cared for through burial or cremation. Because of this, there is much more time available to plan the event and to make decisions about how you'd like to celebrate the life of your loved one.

GETTING STARTED

Before you start planning the finer details of the service, there are a few things you need to think about as they will determine the where, when, and how of your celebration of life:
